

Seder and Scripture – (Community Life-Bible Resources)

Romans 11:13, 17-18 I am speaking to you who are Gentiles regarding Israel...Some of the branches of the olive tree were broken off, and you, being a wild olive, were **grafted** in among them and became partaker with them of the rich root of the olive tree, do not be arrogant toward the branches; but if you are arrogant, remember that it is not you who supports the root, but the root supports you.

Married women lighting of candles (Rashi-Talmud Shabbat)

Court of the Women feast of the tabernacles-Candelabra symbolizing the Pillar of fire: **John 8:12** Then Jesus again spoke to them, saying, "I am the **Light** of the world; he who follows Me will not walk in the darkness, but will have the **Light** of life."

Revelation 19:7 ⁷ "Let us rejoice and be glad and give the glory to Him, for the marriage of the Lamb has come and His **bride** has made herself ready."

2. Washing of hands/Washing of feet

John 13:4-5 ⁴ Jesus got up from supper, and laid aside His garments; and taking a towel, He girded Himself. ⁵ Then He poured water into the basin, and began to wash the disciples' feet and to wipe them with the towel with which He was girded.

Psalms 24:3-4 ³ Who may ascend into the hill of the LORD? And who may stand in His holy place? ⁴ He who has **clean hands** and a pure heart, Who has not lifted up his soul to falsehood And has not sworn deceitfully.

3. Wine cups and remembrance

Mark 14:25 ²⁵ "Truly I say to you, I will never again drink of the **fruit of the vine** until that day when I drink it new in the kingdom of God."

4. Unleavened Bread

John 6:33-35 ³³ "For the bread of God is that which comes down out of heaven, and gives life to the world."
³⁴ Then they said to Him, "Lord, always give us this bread."
³⁵ Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life;

he who comes to Me will not hunger, and he who believes in Me will never thirst.

5. Exodus 12:21 ff Blood of the lamb on the lentel and dooposts-cross

6. Shank bone of the Lamb – symbolizes Jesus

John 1:29 ²⁹ The next day he saw Jesus coming to him and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!

7. Hidden Bread – Jesus can be found by those who look for him

Mark 8:17 ¹⁷ And Jesus, aware of this, said to them, "Why do you discuss *the fact* that you have no bread? Do you not yet see or understand? Do you have a hardened heart?"

8. Eucharistic Prayer & the third cup

Luke 22:15-16,18 And He said to them, "I have earnestly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer; ¹⁶ for I say to you, I shall never again eat it until it is fulfilled in the kingdom of God." And I say to you, I will not drink of the fruit of the vine from now on until the kingdom of God comes."

1 Corinthians 11:23-24 ²³ For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you, that the Lord Jesus in the night in which He was betrayed took bread; ²⁴ and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, "This is My body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of Me."

9. Fourth Cup - Ending – Revelation 21:2-4

² And I saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, made ready as a bride adorned for her husband. ³ And I heard a loud voice from the throne, saying, "Behold, the tabernacle of God is among men, and He will dwell among them, and they shall be His people, and God Himself will be among them, ⁴ and He will wipe away every tear from their eyes; and there will no longer be *any* death; there will no longer be *any* mourning, or crying, or pain; the first things have passed away."
